Congratulations to our June Puppy Preschool Graduates!

Puppy preschool was developed so that puppies can socialise together in a safe environment prior to completing their full puppy vaccination course. It is critical that puppies are socialised properly and safely to help prevent them developing aggression or anxiety associated behaviours. Because the puppies have not yet completed their vaccination course, we ensure that the classes are held indoors only and the area is to be thoroughly disinfected prior to the classes.

What you and your pup will learn from our classes:

- Why it's important to vaccinate against specific diseases
- Why we advise protection against intestinal worms, heart worm and fleas.
- Grooming and bathing your puppy to help prevent skin disease.

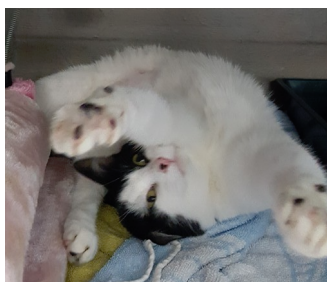


Have you meet our Female cat available for adoption?

Blocked Water Works in Cats



Feline Lower Urinary Tract Disease. Feline Idiopathic Cystitis. Is a disease that results in inflammation of the bladder and/or urethra. The condition may result in partial or complete obstruction of the urinary tract. Risk factors can include: stress, low activity, greater than 1 cat household, dry diets, obesity and neutering. Usual presentation is in cats between the ages of 2-6 years.

Clinical signs: straining during urination, passing small amounts of urine, blood tinged urine, attempting to urinate more frequently, abdominal pain, restlessness and licking at genitals. If left untreated they can become lethargic, start vomiting, in-appetence. Complete obstruction of the urinary tract can be life threatening if left untreated.

If you ever notice your cat straining to urinate make sure you contact you vet ASAP.
